Little by little we are returning to normal life. However, we still have some restrictions that prevent us from doing the things we would like to do, but at the same time God is providing opportunities to minister to various people.

During this journey we had the privilege of teaching the Word of God, guiding more than 70 people to accept Christ as their Savior, and baptizing 25 people from different communities. This place also needs a place to have church meetings



All this family was baptized, and they are using their home in order to have services



We thank God for the privilege of doing the following:

- 150 bags of food delivered.
- 25 baptized.
- We preached and taught the word of God to more than 450 people.
- We delivered more than 30 Bibles in Quechua (the Andean language of that region)
- We had VBS for 3 days with 70 children.

Prayer requests

- Provision to help these communities in order to buy land, and build a church.
- We want to return to this place this month with bags of school supplies for the children.
- We want to help a radio station to build a repeater antenna in these communities, so they can listen to the radio.
- We want to provide solar radios so families can listen to a radio station in their own language.
