Calvary Chapel Caneille is rejoicing after the government in Haiti allowed the churches to reopen again after 3 months of being closed due to the Coronavirus. It was hard for all of us to stay connected because not everyone has the technology to join online or by an application. We tried as hard as we could to create a WhatsApp group to communicate with at least those who have a cell phone. The first day the church was reopened it was like a party, the people missed the fellowship. The radio station was a good tool to reach the people and feed them at a distance.

Praise God everything is back to normal at the church, all the ministries are doing great.



Offices and Guest House

In the compound we have the offices at the bottom and the guest house upstairs. We have been facing a problem for at least more than 2 years. The building of the offices and the guest house shares the same wall of the church. The problem is the roof of the church attaches to the wall of the office building. The concrete wall of the office is detached from the outside wall which allows all of the water coming from the church roof to go straight inside the two rooms we currently use for prayer and our church office.



We can no longer use the two rooms in the back; we must open all the windows and doors to circulate fresh air and clear the mold spores for the two rooms in the front. It is urgent that the mold issue is fixed. Not only to prevent the building from rotting, but to keep everyone healthy. We believe at this point this is an emergency we can no longer ignore or put on the back burner. We need building experts to find a solution and financial help to see the project through. Please pray for God to provide people and resources to get our compound building fixed!





Currently all of the buildings need to be painted and some needed repairs also. We were able to do a big touch up on the radio station, repainting it inside and outside. It is a big relief to have them done. Everyone is happy to have a nice and clean place to come and worship. We thank you all for your support. I am happy to report the water truck is in good working order!

Since we are in a rainy season, we are able to catch rainwater and save fuel and transportation fees.



The generator is also in great shape and it is running very well.



Economic Crisis in Haiti

Everything is expensive due to the American dollar exchange in Haiti. The problem previously was that the dollar exchange was \$120 Gourdes for one US dollar. Food and gas is expensive and food, but at least when you exchange \$100 US it gives you more Haitian money to buy. The US dollar kept increasing in value. President Jovenel Moise is working the election and trying to show the population he is working on their behalf. He decided to bring the American money exchange down with a plan, now foods and other items have brought the cost down. So today the American dollar exchange is now \$60

Gourdes for one US dollar and prices of many things are staying the same or going down a little bit. It is so hard for people to survive, especially missionaries that are being supported by friends in the USA. No one knows what to do because no budget can be implemented and if the new exchange prices stays, we may have to recalculate everything to see how we can make it.



The kids filled their bags with rice as they came to register for next school year!

Due to the coronavirus, the school year will restart again in November. We are doing registration now, sewing the uniforms quickly to receive the kids again in November. Praise the Lord the school year has ended very well! It is always a joy to see the parents together with the kids planning for the future for them. We are glad we can be a small part in their life for the kids. Thank you so much for all your help and support.

Since he has 4 sisters, he asked his mom to have at least the last kid, a boy so he could have a little brother. We had that request many times and prayed about it and the Lord gave us little Hyvens. Hyvens was so welcome in the family but mostly Hyguens was so glad to have a little brother. Hyguens planned to be the one primarily to buy clothes for his little brother because he loved him so much. During the confinement I had to be in the US and went to America to work on a legal document which I found out that would take me longer than I thought. I landed in America on June 16th and left all of the kids healthy with their mom. Unexpectedly, my wife called to say Hyguens had a pain in his stomach. We rushed him to the hospital in Hinche. The doctors found out it was his appendix and needed surgery at the Port Au Prince Hospital. The next day we went to the hospital in Port Au Prince with him and he passed away July 26, 2020. Hyguens left an empty space in the family. He was helping in the sound room and the radio. We miss him so much! We are holding on to this picture to share with Hyvens when he is older. I thank you all who knew about it and supported us in that hard time. Please continue to pray for the family.
